Guidelines for Food Distribution

June 9, 2020

The Harbor Church is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for our members and guests. The following steps are being taken to ensure that our facilities are safe and family-friendly, and are providing impactful experiences.

- Our building is clean and sanitized, and we are limiting access – Guests will be invited into the building in groups of 5
- Doors (including restrooms) are to be left open so people don't touch the handle
- Rooms will be limited to 50% occupancy
- Consumption of food and beverages is NOT allowed (individual water bottles are okay)
- No hugging, shaking hands or high fives please - just waving and saying hello
- We are implementing ongoing sanitization – surfaces and common touch points will be wiped down frequently. Grocery carts will be sanitized between each usage
- Social distancing of six feet will be maintained between volunteers and guests at all times. We ask guests to maintain at least 6 feet of distance between themselves and the person (family) in front of them at all times
- We encourage but do not require people to wear masks. If you choose not to wear a mask be respectful of those with greater feelings of concern. People who feel lesser degrees of concern should in all cases respect the concerns of others. Our conduct should be more about loving others than who is right or wrong
- We encourage but do not require people to wear protective gloves. Volunteers handling food are required to wear gloves
- We ask guests to point to your selections rather than touch food and other items. We want our guests to be able to select the food they want and need. Our workers will provide the selected items for the guests to pick up and put in their cart
- Because of social distancing restrictions, we are temporarily changing our prayer ministry. We have prayer request forms to be filled out and dropped it at the Food Distribution entry table. Our prayer teams will be praying for the prayer needs
- Volunteers and guests will be required to sign The Harbor Church COVID-19 Liability Waiver
- For guests who prefer to remain in their car or for anyone who is unable to sign the COVID-19 Liability Waiver, we will have someone “shop” and deliver the food
- Volunteers or guests who are not willing to adhere to these guidelines will not be allowed in the building
